

What is fluoride varnish?

Fluoride varnish is a protective coating painted onto teeth. It helps prevent new cavities by making the tooth enamel harder.

Is fluoride varnish safe?

Yes. Fluoride varnish is safe, even for children and babies. The use of fluoride varnish is approved and recommended by Health Canada and the Canadian Dental Association.

Why is fluoride varnish recommended?

Children can get cavities soon after their first baby teeth appear. Cavities in baby teeth may cause pain and prevent children from being able to eat, speak, sleep and learn properly.
