COVID-19 Assessment Centre

Currently, there are no confirmed cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) in our community or local surrounding areas. We are taking every possible measure to identify early cases and prevent community spread. This is a VERY serious situation and we all need to take necessary steps to reduce the risks to our community. We have opened a COVID-19 Assessment Centre. The purpose of this centre is to identify possible community cases that meet the current criteria set by Public Health listed below.

The COVID-19 Assessment Centre will be located at the Chapleau Recreation Centre in the Community Hall at 4 Maple Street.

The Assessment Centre will be available by appointment **ONLY**. You must come alone to your appointment unless directed otherwise. Walk-ins are strictly prohibited and will be turned away.

If you have any of the following symptoms, please call **1-866-522-9200** to be screened for an appointment:

- Fever (above 38°C)
- New or worsened cough
- New or worsened shortness of breath

AND any of the following within 14 days before symptoms of illness started:

- Have traveled outside of Canada
- Had close interactions with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19
- Had close interactions with someone who has symptoms of COVID-19 who recently travelled outside of Canada or to an impacted area within Canada

Do **NOT** go to our local emergency department for the purpose of COVID-19 screening. Remember to call the local screening number at **1-866-522-9200**

The emergency department is open for emergencies **ONLY**. Call Telehealth at **1-866-797-0000** if you are unsure of the best place for you to go.
