Re: New Residential Garbage Bin Containers/Tuff Boxes

---

In the next coming weeks Public Works will be distributing new residential metal garbage bins/boxes to households on reserve. Each household will receive one (1) bin to use which will be placed in area deemed suitable for Public Works to perform their responsibility of garbage removal, plowing of driveways, or other yard/maintenance work. To reduce the risk of encountering a bear(s) or other unwanted animals the bins should not be placed alongside or too close to entrances to your home/buildings. **These bins will remain the property of Chapleau Cree First Nation and should not be removed/relocated from the First Nation.** The most ideal location for most residents would be to place the bins close to the end of your driveway near the roadway however, some household driveways are on a steep slope, and this may not be suitable. ***Should you designate an area which would be deemed suitable with Public Works please contact Eric Caldwell as soon as possible at 705-864-9090 or email [publicworks@chapleaucree.ca](mailto:publicworks@chapleaucree.ca) to confirm location. Also, a new large garbage bin has been installed near bum town on Margaret Ann Road for residents to use.***

Coexisting with black bears often means keeping them from getting food and garbage from around your home, business, and parks. Below are some tips to store garbage and reduce potential bear encounters.

Improperly stored garbage is the most common cause of human-bear conflicts. Storing garbage out of the reach of bears can prevent them from returning to your home, park, or camp. Remember that bear-resistant bins must be properly latched and regularly cleaned to prevent the odors that attract bears.

Parents/families/communities talk to children/visitors about being respectful with properly disposing of garbage during walks, playtime, playgrounds, beaches etc. in being equally careful in managing your garbage when using your community's parks and pathways. Bears that move through town often use the green spaces as travel corridors. Garbage left in these spaces may encourage the bears to stay and seek out further food sources. Keep the parks and pathways clean by using the bear-resistant bins and pack your garbage home when bear-resistant bins are not available.

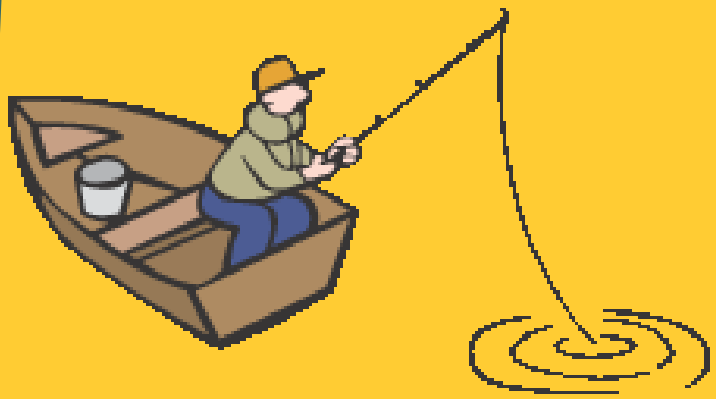

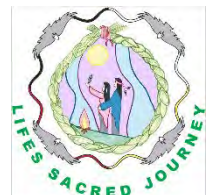
