Effective Wednesday, May 13, 2020, Chapleau Cree First Nation offices will remain closed to the general public and continue to provide <u>ESSENTIAL SERVICES ONLY</u> to our members and business associates. This decision was made to continue to ensure the safety of both our employees and the community at large.

A limited staff on a rotating schedule will continue to work from our offices as required. All employees who are not scheduled are expected to be working from home until June 2, 2020. Chapleau Cree staff will be available by phone, email, and other forms of communication during regular business hours. For your safety and that of our employees and community members, we ask that you do not visit our office during this time. Should you feel that you have an emergent matter, please call our office to arrange an appointment with the appropriate staff.

A Chapleau Cree First Nation travel band in already in place for all staff. Additionally, a restriction has been imposed on visitors to the Chapleau Cree First Nation community by **BCR #2020-10**. All meetings, events and activities are cancelled until further notice.

Our senior manager team and Councillors will continue to meet weekly to review operation planning for each department. We ask for patience during this time. I can assure you that we are doing everything possible to assist and support our community, keeping safety and security as our primary concern, while we navigate this difficult time together.
