 - Ordinarily a resident on reserve or in recognized communities

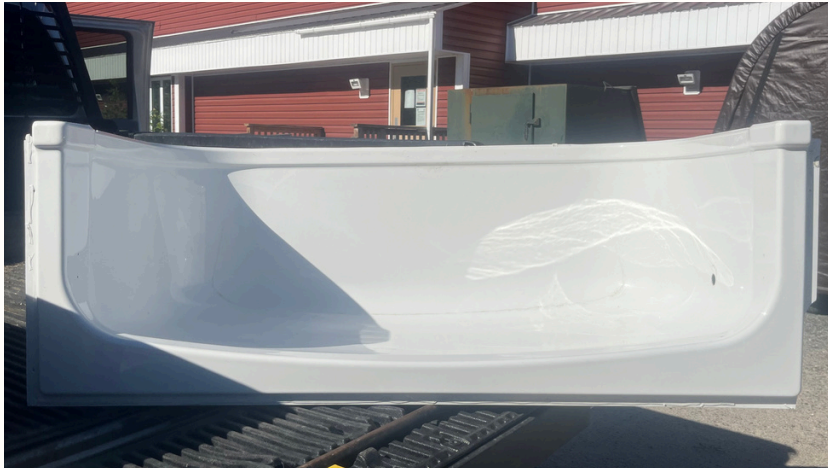
