Wahkohtowin Development and our owner First Nations of Brunswick House First Nation, Chapleau Cree First Nation, and Missanabie Cree First Nation have launched a new project to conserve and steward our Nations' traditional Lands through Parks Canada's Ecological Corridors program!

An ecological corridor is "A clearly defined geographical space where governance, management and stewardship over the long term maintain or restore effective ecological connectivity while upholding Indigenous stewardship values"

Over the next year, we will be meeting with community members to discuss how to be responsible Guardians of the Land. The knowledge and stories shared in these sessions will guide what Land we acquire for the corridor and how we steward that Land going forward.

Micro-Subdivision Project Phase Two Tree Clearing and Soil Testing


CCFN has selected an area to the south of Lindy Louttit Lane to be prepared for development into 22 ten-meter lots.

Trees will be cleared from the roadway and from paths to allow for soil testing on future septic beds. Phase 3 will extend water mains, Hydro One Lines and road surfaces.

These lots will be available for future housing development, but this project does not include new houses, only lot preparation.

“Living the Good Life” living an addictions free lifestyle and who are role models within the community promoting an Addictions Free Lifestyle.

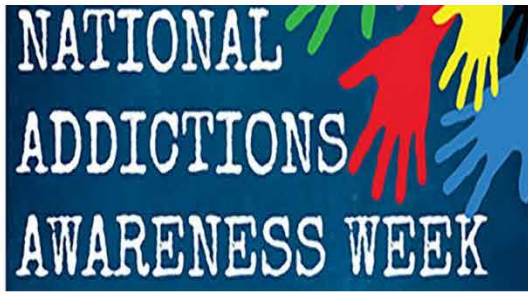
