HRV Maintenance and Energy Inspections

Recently there have been some inspections of on-reserve rental homes by **CLEAResult Canada** and by **One Source Home Services**.

CLEAResult did energy efficiency assessments. We are hoping to use this program to get Heat Pumps installed at eligible properties. This is still in progress. I will keep everyone informed but there is no news yet.

One Source has been doing work on heating and cooling systems in public buildings and in some homes.

They will be back to make sure that the HRV systems in all the rental homes are serviced and ready for winter.

I will make sure that there is plenty of notice for the maintenance work—we are planning on the 29th and 30th of July, but I will send notices to individuals next week.
